



A SERVICE CREW'S GUIDE TO
SPECTATING AT THIS YEAR'S RALLY

The organising committee of the Catlins Coast Rally have planned this year's rally to be as service-crew friendly as possible. We encourage you to get out to the stages and see as much of the action as you can.

We have listed below the spectator points where we believe you will see the most cars in the time available.

Special Stage 1: Head down to the spectator area on this stage as early as you can (the first car will pass approx 9:25am) you can watch the next 20-25 cars **after** your car passes.

Special Stage 4: If your car is in the first half of the field then go to this spot. You can view approx 40 cars **after** your car passes.

Special Stage 5: Go to this spot if your car is in the last half of the field. You will need to leave around 5 mins after your car has passed. [This area will obviously suit crews servicing cars further back in the field as you should be able to see at least 50 cars before yours arrives.]

Special Stage 6: Leave the Owaka service area as quickly as possible – follow your road book to Romahapa and turn left onto Romahapa Rd. This should be a good spot. If you just want to see your car then you can catch them again at SS7 spectator point.

Special Stage 7: Leave the Owaka service area as quickly as possible – follow your road book to Gray Rd, leave your trailer on the gravel area at the start of this road. Then follow directions on the spectator map. Leave immediately your car passes in order to make the service in time.
Alternatively a non- advertised spectating spot that is easy for service crews to access is to your left at the first intersection on Cheetwood Rd.

REMEMBER! You represent the rally, **please** drive courteously. No alcohol is to be consumed until your car has finished the rally. We currently enjoy an excellent relationship with the residents and police. The future of the Catlins Coast Rally relies on us maintaining this relationship; please don't jeopardise it!
