1. Jurisdiction

This event is a Rallysprint promoted by the Eastern Southland Car Club and will take place on **Saturday March 24th 2018** at Popotunoa in South Otago.

It will be held under MotorSport NZ’s National Sporting Code and its appendices and schedules, particularly;

Appendix 3, Schedule RS for the Rallysprint, and

Appendix 2, Schedule A for Vehicle and Driver Requirements.

3. The Event

Venue – Popotunoa South Otago. Sign posted from SH1 south of Clinton and north of Waipahi..

Length – Leg 1, 9.7 km public road in excellent condition.

Leg 2, 9.6 km public road in excellent condition (leg 1 in opposite direction)

Scrutineering – 7:30am to 8:30am

Start – 9:00 am (Competitor briefing)

Entry Fee - \$150

- \$190 late entry

Classes - A 0 - 1300
 B 1301 -1600
 C 1601 & over
 D 4WD

NOTE - Vehicles in addition to Schedule A must also comply with the additional requirements for rally vehicles listed in **Appendix 2, Article 7.**

Competitor Requirements - Drivers must hold as a minimum a MSNZ **M Grade** licence, Cars must carry a passenger - they don't require a MSNZ licence but **must attend the competitors briefing** and sign an indemnity form. Minimum requirements are 2 layer overalls for both driver and passenger.

Competition - The event will start with an Indian file run of leg 1 then leg 2 followed by up to 3 official runs on each leg (6 runs max). The results will be determined by combining a competitor's fastest single run on leg 1 with their fastest single run on leg 2.

Start Order - Cars will start each run through the course in seeded order, any variation to the start order requires the approval of the Clerk of the Course.

Entries are to be made out on the correct form and to be deemed to be valid must be complete in every detail and accompanied by the appropriate fees.

Acceptance will be at the Clerk of the Course's discretion.

2 driver entries in the same car must be notified at time of entry and will be at the Clerk of the Courses discretion.

Late entries will be accepted up until the start of the event at the Clerk of the Course's discretion, but may be subject to the late entry fee.

Event organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

The maximum number of starters will be 50.

In signing the entry forms, competitors are deemed to fully understand the relevant articles and regulations as contained in the MotorSport NZ Manual.

5. Licence requirements

The driver must hold an **M Grade** licence or higher and be a member of a MSNZ affiliated club.

6. Official notice board

Will be at the ESCC van.

7. Results

Will be posted at the ESCC van and at the conclusion of the event at the prize giving venue.

8. Servicing

At the Popotunua Hall after completion of leg 2 each time.

(There is a 5km public road loop back to the service area from the end of leg 1)
