1. Jurisdiction

This is part of the Eastern Car Club's Club Championship. Points will be awarded in their normal classes.

It will be held under MotorSport New Zealand's National Sporting Code and its appendices and schedules, particularly;
Appendix 2, Schedule A for Vehicle and Driver Requirements.

Please Note the new Protective Clothing requirements, for all occupants of a competing car.

Full length Cotton or Wool, only mandatory where a single layer suit is worn.

3. The Event

Venue – Ernslaw One Forest Conical Hills

Length – 2.0 km of hard based gravel forest road.

Scrutineering / Documentation – 9-30 am – 11-00 am

Start – 11:00 am (Drivers briefing)

Entry Fee - \$60-00
\$50 Under 18 year olds

Classes - A 0 - 1300
 B 1301 -1600
 C 1601 & over
 D 4WD

Competitor Requirements - Drivers must hold as a minimum a MSNZ **M Grade** licence.
Passengers must sign passenger declaration form.

Competition - The event will start with an Indian file followed by 4 official runs with your fastest run counting towards your result. Provision is available for two driver cars.

4. Entries

Entry is to be on the day.

Acceptance will be at the Clerk of the Course's discretion.

Event organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

In signing the entry forms, competitors are deemed to fully understand the relevant articles and regulations as contained in the MotorSport NZ Manual.

5. Licence requirements

The driver must hold an **M** Grade licence or higher and be a member of a MSNZ affiliated club.

6. Official notice board

Will be at the ESCC van stationed at the start line.

7. Results

Will be posted at start area and at the conclusion of the event.

8. Pit Area

Is the roadside along River Road. (Please keep access along the road clear at all times)
Also please note this is where any refuelling is to take place.
